I. THE FLAGSHIP: THE MATTHIAS JONES MYSTERIES

Genre: Procedural Dramedy / "Granite Noir"

Scope: 14 Completed Novels (14+ Seasons of Episodic Content)

The Hook: A three-sport college coach with "Detective DNA" navigates a town of eccentric locals, corrupt power players, and the New England Mafia. Think *Bosch* meets *The Rockford Files* set in a coastal New Hampshire college town.

Key Characters:

- **Matthias Jones:** The "Student of Detail." Persistent, principled, and often driven to apoplectic rage by the local incompetence.
- **Cocoa Stefani:** The streetwise owner of Club Max. The bridge to the underworld.
- **Hamilton Fletcher:** The all-controlling patriarch who owns the town.
- **The Nemesis:** DA Herbert Lane and his ego-centric, gold-jewelry-laden assistant.
- **The "Townies:"** A deep bench of recurring characters (**Lark Larson, Bucky Driscoll, Arnie Dewers**) and a host of unique characters that provide consistent humor and subplots.

Pilot Episode (R.I.P. Bill Jones): The series begins when Jones wins the national high school football championship and is recruited by Cocoa Stefani to coach at Hamilton College. But there's a glitch. His dad, a veteran investigator, is murdered. Jones and Cocoa become friends tracking down Bill Jones's killer. Their efforts are thwarted by little Lester Larsen, son of the retiring bumbling coach Lark Larsen as he attempts to prevent Jones from replacing his father as coach.

II. THE HISTORICAL FRANCHISE: THE PATCH KINCAID SERIES

Genre: Historical Thriller / Forensic Sci-Fi

Scope: 4 Volumes + Extensive Research Archive

A forensic deep dive into the 20th century's greatest conspiracies. Backed by 873 sourced footnotes in **Return to Dallas** and in collaboration with the Sixth Floor Museum's Oral History Project, this series uses a "time-displaced" hero who witnesses the assassinations of JFK, RFK, and MLK with an introspective but terrifying logic.

A high-concept odyssey that connects a technologically advanced future with a metaphoric Jungian odyssey from a foundational origin story set in the college town of **Appleton, Vermont**.
